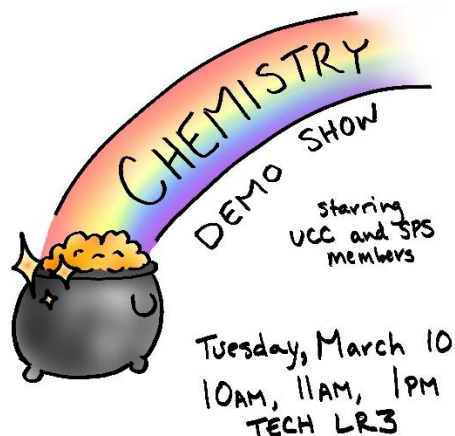
Registration is now open for the Chem 519-0 Responsible Conduct of Research instructor-led course.

The Chemistry Department offers this required course once a year, during the spring quarter. PhD students register for the course through Caesar; postdocs and visiting scholars register through myHR Learn.

Successful completion of **BOTH** the online and instructor led course is required of all graduate students, postdocs and visiting scholars. Failure to do so may negatively impact your funding.

Northwestern uses the **CITI** program for the online course. Graduate students, postdocs and visiting scholars should complete the CITI course, "RCR course for graduate students and postdocs"; undergraduate students should complete the CITI course, "RCR course for undergraduate students".

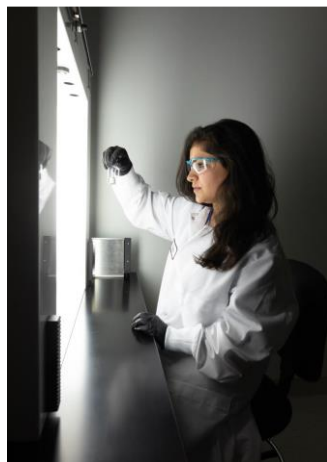
